



# Do you believe there will be a water shortage in central Indiana in the future?



## Do you support the Mounds Lake Project?




# Do you feel that information on Mounds Lake is easily accessible?



## A few points to take away:

- Approximately 72% of responders are in support of the Mounds Lake project.
- Approximately 88% of responders acknowledge that a need for water does or will exist in our region.
- Approximately 13% of responders do not support the Mounds Lake project.


#### Top Ranked Concerns



#### Of the 1,230 responders:

- 344 (28%) ranked Cost and Finance as their top concern
- 197 (16%) ranked Ground Water Contamination as their top concern
- 197 (16%) ranked *Environmental Concerns* as their top concern
- 172 (14%) ranked *Property Acquisition* as their top concern
- 160 (13%) ranked Bridges and Roads as their top concern
- 86 (7%) ranked Public Access to Mounds Lake as their top concern
- 49 (4%) ranked Parks and Trails as their top concern
- 25 (2%) did not choose a ranking.

### Where do you get information about Mounds Lake?



#### Of the 1,230 responders:

- 239 (19%) get their information from "Other" sources
- 698 (57%) get their information from the Newspaper
- 216 (18%) get their information from Facebook
- 20 (2%) get their information from Twitter
- 502 (41%) get their information from MoundsLake.com

## A few points to take away:

- More people are concerned about the cost of the project and the environmental impact/ground water contamination than any other issue.
- Over 50% of the responders get their information from the newspaper.

## Top Ranked Concerns - FAQ

## Cost and Finance

- Estimated cost of the proposed Mounds Lake project \$400 million
- Funding sources being sought for the project include:
  - · Private foundation monies,
  - · Water utility revenue.

NOTE: While many avenues of paying for this project are being explored, NONE involve local taxpayers.

### Ground Water Contamination/Environmental Concerns

According to the Study performed by SESCO of Indianapolis, the following has been determined:

- There is no known contamination of any level coming from affected areas with the exception of the GM site.\*
- Sampling of the White River has shown no contamination from any of the affected area.
- Of the total site, focus has been narrowed to about 160 acres of commercial/industrial development within or near the proposed pool about 80 acres of this is in the impacted area and would require additional examination from current or previous impact.

## **Property Acquisition**

The Coporation for Economic Development for Anderson/Madison County (CED) is **NOT** acquiring property at this time.

When property acquisition is necessary, the CED will immediately notify the public and ensure the compassionate, responsible, ethical, and moral management of such transactions.
